As we continue our Lenten journey together, our parishes are offering a variety of opportunities for you to respond to the call of the Lord: “Repent, and believe in the Gospel!” There are more than **30 hours of Confessions** scheduled throughout the season in all three of our parishes! As Pope Francis recently said, “Don’t be afraid of Confession!” In addition to the normal Confession schedule in our parishes (**Saturdays** 7:00-7:45 PM at Elmwood and **Sundays** 7:45-8:15 AM at Boyceville), the Sacrament of Reconciliation is also offered **Wednesdays** 6:00-7:30 PM at Elmwood; on **Tuesday, March 10**, 7:30-9:00 PM and **Sunday, March 15**, 11:30 AM-3:00 PM at Spring Valley; on **Saturday, March 14**, 11:00 AM-2:00 PM and **Monday, March 30**, 5:00-6:30 PM at Boyceville; and **Monday, March 23**, 7:00 PM Communal Penance Service at Saint Joseph, Menomonie. The words of Saint John Paul II, I make my own: **“To those who have been far away from the Sacrament of Reconciliation and forgiving love I make this appeal: come back to this source of grace; do not be afraid! Christ Himself is waiting for you. He will heal you, and you will be at peace with God!”** Come and encounter our merciful Lord and Savior!

In addition to carving out time for **prayer at home and as a family**, essential to any Lenten spiritual program is regular participation in the **Holy Sacrifice of the Mass** in observance of the **Lord’s Day** (Vigil on Saturday or Sunday itself). As your schedule allows, you might additionally assist at **Mass** celebrated in the mornings and evenings on **weekdays**. Also, consider spending some time **before the Blessed Sacrament which is exposed continuously at Spring Valley** beginning at 5:00 PM Thursday through 8:00 PM Friday and Mondays at **Boyceville** from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM. **Morning Prayer** from the Liturgy of the Hours is prayed within the context of Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament following the 8:00 AM Mass on Thursdays at Spring Valley. One of the most popular devotions during the Season of Lent is meditating on that last journey of Jesus through the streets of Jerusalem to His saving Death on the Cross by praying the **Stations of the Cross**. The Way of the Cross prayed within the context of **Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament** Tuesdays at **Spring Valley** at 7:00 PM and Fridays at **Elmwood** at 7:30 PM.

Beginning this Monday I am offering a three-part presentation **“Who Do You Say That I Am: Coming to Know Jesus Through the Scriptures and the Holy Land.”** The first session, **“Repent and Believe in the Gospel: Jesus Proclaims the Kingdom,”** is Monday, March 2, at 7:00 PM at Spring Valley. The second, **“It is Finished: Jesus Embraces His Passion and Death,”** is Monday, March 9, at 7:00 PM at Spring Valley. The final session, **“He is Risen: The Father Raises Jesus from the Dead,”** is Monday, March 16, at 7:00 PM at Elmwood.

Saint Luke Parish is once again hosting our parishes’ **day of prayer and reflection** on **Saturday, March 14**, 9:00 AM-3:00 PM featuring Deacons Kevin Ray and Michael Cullen. Besides the inspiring talks by these Deacons, the day includes Confessions and Mass as well as a light breakfast and lunch.
