**PASTORAL REFLECTION**  
**Trinity Sunday**

Usually I don't print my humor in the bulletin reflection, since this week I will be in Cincinnati, Ohio; I can share this one with you.

At Confirmation, the archbishop asked the children for a definition of the Holy Trinity. A girl answered very softly, "The Holy Trinity is three Persons in one God." The archbishop, who was almost deaf, replied, "I didn't understand what you said." And the young theologian before him replied, "You are not supposed to. The Trinity is a mystery."

With the Sign of the Cross, we trace the Trinity on ourselves. We bring God into our minds first. Then we bring the Trinity down to our hearts. And, with our hearts filled with compassion, we move the Trinity across our bodies to our shoulders and arms to better bear the burdens of our family and friends.

The Trinity feast goes back to 12th century England and St Thomas Becket, Archbishop of Canterbury. Historians say the great Thomas celebrated a Liturgy in honor of the Trinity in his cathedral. So was born the observance. This is a feast of a doctrine rather than of an event of salvation. Historically, this started in the year 1030 on the First Sunday after Pentecost. Pope John XXII approved it in 1334 as a Feast of the Universal Church. St Patrick explained Holy Trinity with the three leaf shamrock rising from the one stem.

On the practical level, how does the mystery of Trinity fit in our day-to-day life as Christians? To ponder this mystery more deeply, what comes out is: Community. If there are Three Persons in One God, then, there has to be a community, a unity among the Three. Let us pray for Unity this week.
