Our three parishes serve a sprawling area of our Diocese as evidenced by where our children receive their intellectual formation. Some of our children are homeschooled while the others are enrolled in seven (!) different public school districts, Saint Francis Catholic School (Ellsworth), and Ave Maria Academy (Plum City). ***Congratulations to those who are graduating from one level to the next!*** In particular, we pray for God’s blessings on our high school graduates. May they be open to the continued guidance of the Holy Spirit as they seek to further develop their God-given talents and discover how God desires them to use these talents in service of God and neighbor. We also specially thank Anne Helmer who concludes many years of so skillfully guiding the faith formation program at Spring Valley. May God bless Anne for her generous service!

At this time of year, we are focused on First Holy Communions, working in the fields or gardens, graduations, and the end of the school year. Thoughts of the saving Death and Resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, which we celebrate at Easter, tend to get crowded out with all the busyness of the month of May. So it may seem odd that in our year of faith we are still in the Easter Season. ***Today we celebrate the Ascension of our Risen Lord.*** The *Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church* summarizes the meaning of His Ascension: “After forty days during which Jesus showed Himself to the Apostles with ordinary human features which veiled His glory as the Risen One, Christ ***ascended*** into heaven and was ***seated*** at the right hand of the Father. He is the Lord who now in His humanity ***reigns in the everlasting glory*** of the Son of God and ***constantly intercedes for us*** before the Father. He ***sends us His Spirit*** and He ***gives us the hope*** of one day reaching the place He has prepared for us” (132). As He returned to the Father, Jesus gave to the Apostles and the entire Church our task: “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ***Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them*** in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, ***teaching them to observe*** all that I have commanded you. And behold, ***I am with you always***, until the end of the age” (Matthew 28:16-20).

Next Sunday our celebration of the Paschal Mystery – the Lord’s saving Death and Resurrection by which He overcame sin, death, and hopelessness – comes to its liturgical conclusion with the ***Solemnity of Pentecost***. May our hearts be open to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit whom the Risen and Glorified Christ promised He would send. Come, Holy Spirit, come! Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us! Saint Luke, pray for us!
